Built in 1882, this 9th floor loft in a historic converted building features high ceilings, wood floors, an open floor plan, views of Empire State Building and skyline.

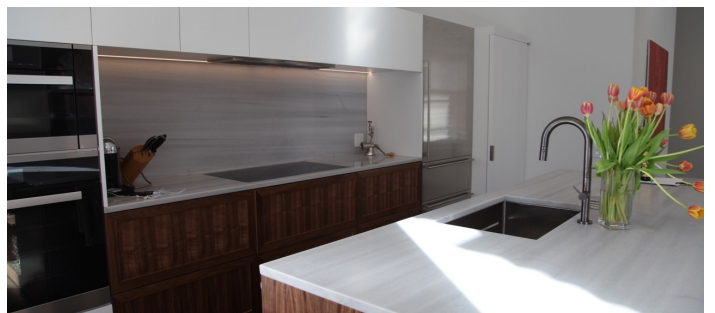
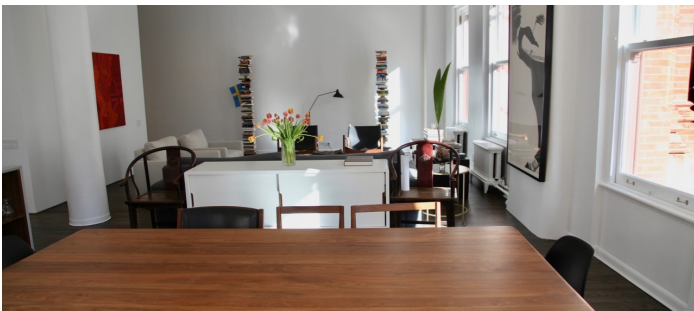
Access to roof from 11th floor via staircase.

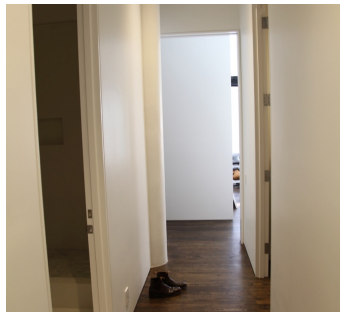
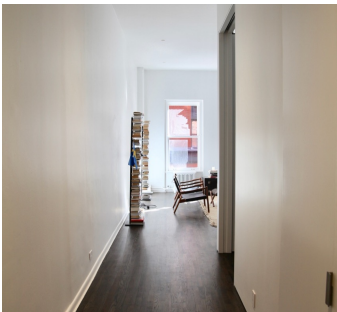

All floors must be protected, booties must be worn over shoes.

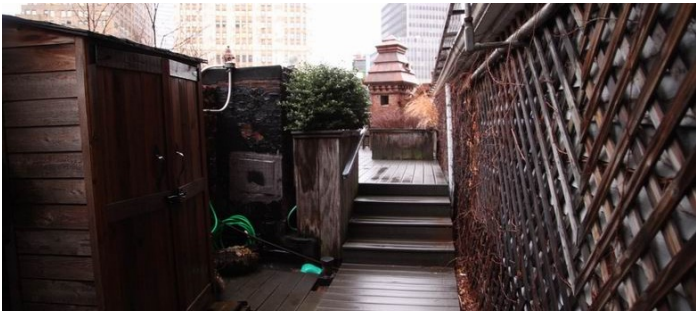
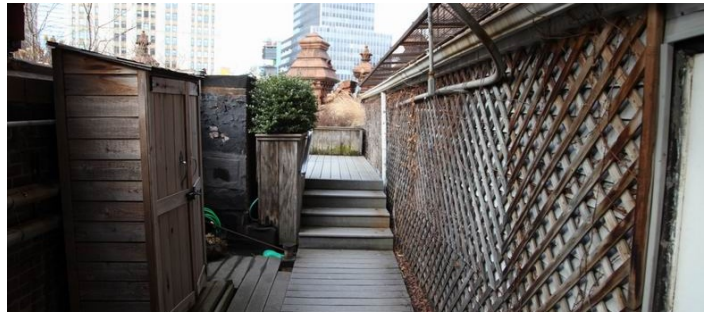
Use of roof, stairwells, lobby, hallway, and common areas all require building approval in advance and additional fees apply.
