Large trucks are not permitted to enter the park/gated community after 5pm and on weekends; semi trucks would have to unload and transfer to smaller trucks at the gate.

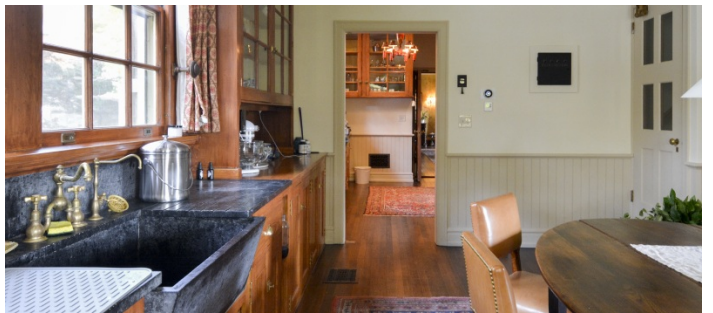






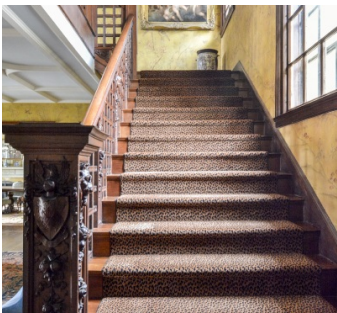


1ST FLOOR
