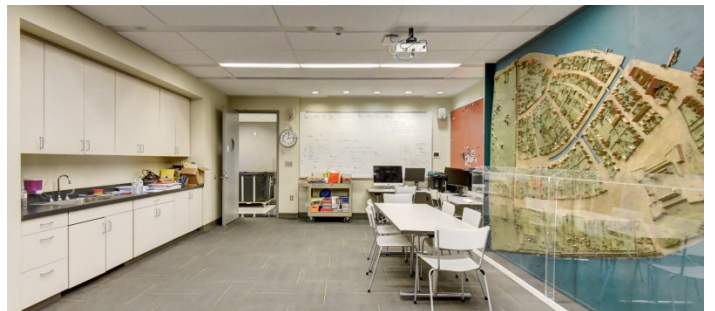
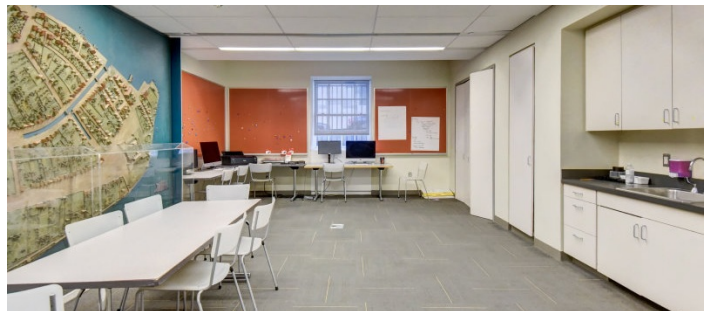
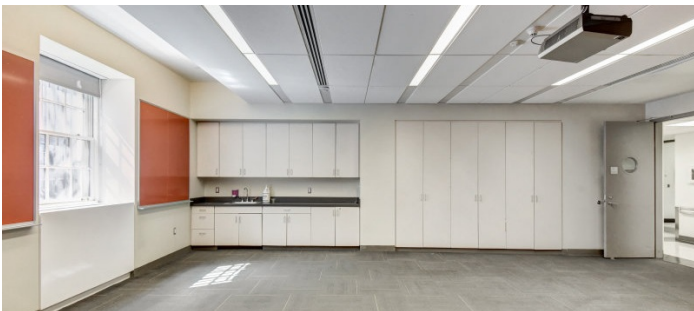
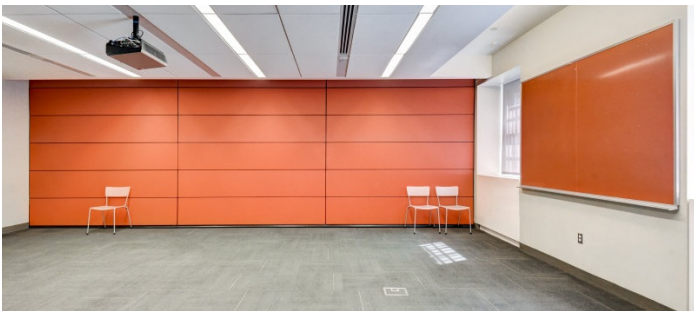
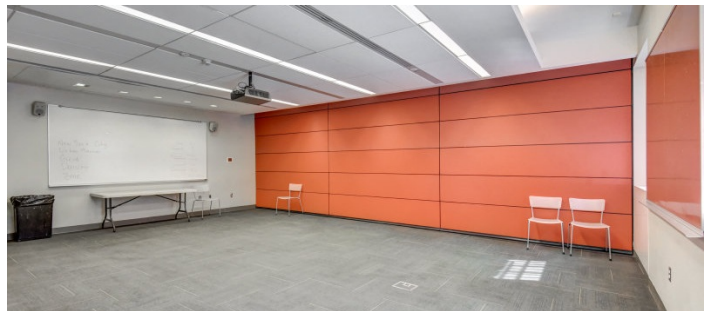
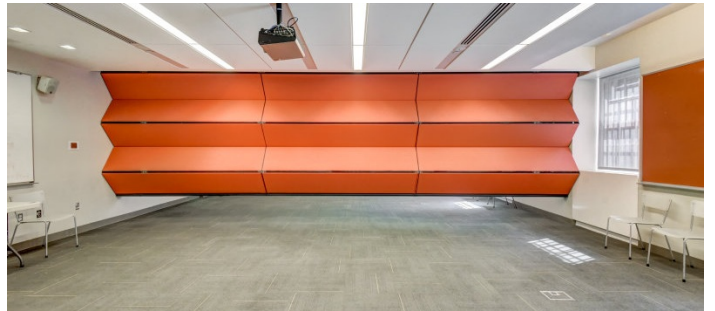
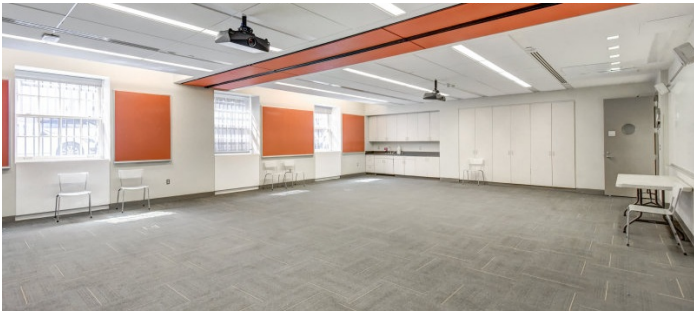




AUDITORIUM ROOM (GROUND FLOOR)
