Home dates back to 1927 and was formerly owned by the Auchinchloss family, cousins of Jackie Kennedy. This three story plus basement colonial was doubled in size in 1998 and renovated in 2016.

Features include: two level living room with wood burning fireplace and French doors leading to a wrap around porch, four bedrooms, 3 bathrooms and 1 powder room, finished basement with wood burning fireplace. A split level deck was added within the last two years including an outdoor modern sculpture from Brooklyn artist.

The backyard has huge old trees, stonework and the Silvermine River that runs through the property. There is also a waterfall across the street (separate clearance required).

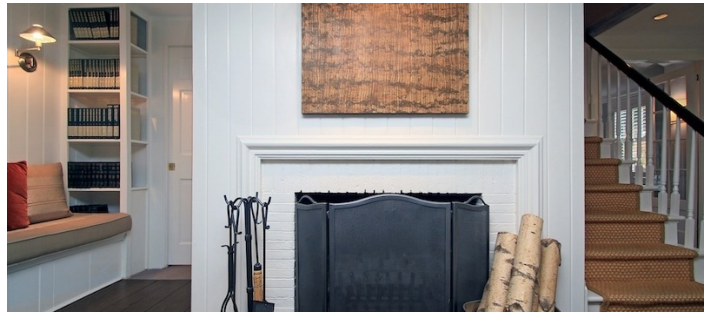
Restrictions:

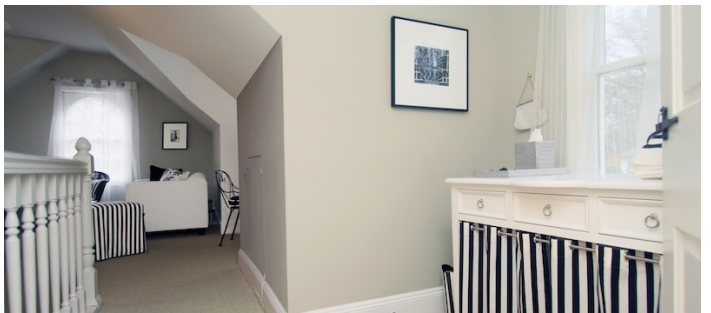
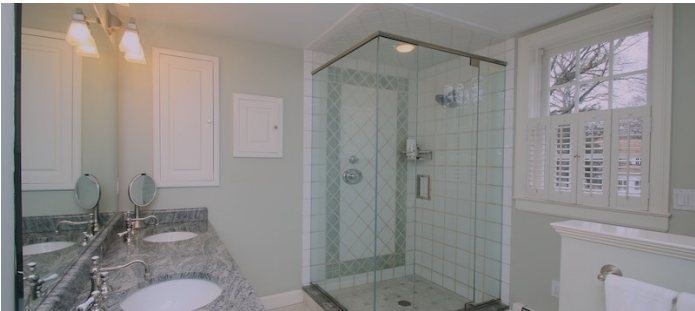
Prefer no shoes inside; please bring shoe covers and protect floors.
