Spectacular Italian kitchen by Dada, which features massive custom designed stainless steel suspended pier work surface. Custom made black steel framed glass wall into bedroom suite area, with open spa bathroom with Pelle Grigio marble walls.

Loft features a collection of unique furniture, including: rare tables and consoles by French sculptor and artist Jerome Abel Seguin; Michael Young for Sawaya & Moroni chairs and tables; Claesson Koivisto Rune custom designed 18 1/2 ft Panga Panga wood Kalahari dining table made by Mabeo in Botswana; hand made African wooden bowls by Andrew Early; Belgian hand blown glass collection, and additional furniture and leather items by Arte Cuoio, Phillip Plein, and Henry Beguelin; accent Bang & Olufsen stereo pieces.
