Notes

Built in 1790, this home has been meticulously restored according to its legacy architecture.

Features include a spacious living room, a library and second living room with working wood fireplace, an expansive dining room with an additional seating area, a sunroom, open kitchen with dining area, 3 bedrooms (including a master with working wood fireplace), and 3 full bathrooms. The open kitchen and dining area has an antique french wine tasting oak table and caned chairs with hand-painted Hudson Valley scenes from the 1890s.

Outside there is expansive blue stone terrace, two swimming holes fed by the Shekomeko, a natural artesian-well spring that was instrumental to the Mohegan Native Americans and Hudson Valley trade.

There is a historic barn on the property that predates the home (so built before 1790) with hand-hewn beams.

Restrictions:

No painting of walls. Requests to nail into old plaster walls must be approved in advance; if approved, must be repaired/returned to original condition upon project completion.

There are two poodle paintings in the home that should not be moved.
